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Background of the Study

- A 2012 study commissioned by the **Colegio de Médicos-Cirujanos** de Puerto Rico demonstrated that the indexing method used by the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to set Medicare fees does not accurately reflect the real costs of practicing medicine in Puerto Rico. The study also demonstrated that the high real costs of practicing medicine on the island combined with low remuneration from Medicare is an important factor in the decision of many Puerto Rican doctors to relocate to the US mainland. However, it should be noted that low reimbursement from Medicare was not as frequently mentioned as a reason to emigrate as the low fees paid to doctors in Puerto Rico by private health insurance providers.
- Almost 60% of the Puerto Rican doctors surveyed who were practicing on the island in 2012 said they were considering to move their practice to the US mainland. Of these doctors, 90% said that one of the main factors was higher fees paid by private health insurance providers in the States, and 77% mentioned that one of the major factors was higher fees paid by Medicare in the States. Of the sample of Puerto Rican doctors who had transferred their practice to the States, 71% said that the low fees paid by private health insurance providers in Puerto Rico had been a factor in their decision to move their medical practice elsewhere.

Background of the Study (continued)

- The **Colegio** decided to conduct a study to quantify to what degree fees paid to doctors as well as fees paid for standard medical services by private health insurers in Puerto Rico are lower than in the 50 States in order to determine the importance of this factor in stimulating an exodus of physicians from the island. The **Colegio** is concerned that the exodus of physicians from the island to the mainland may increase drastically in the next decade, which could create shortages of critical medical services for an aging population.
- The primary aim of the study was to look at billing practices and compare fees paid by private health plans in Puerto Rico and the US mainland for: (a) initial and subsequent visits to a doctor's office, and (b) common medical procedures performed by different categories of PCPs and Specialists. The present report represents the first half of the study namely the fees paid to Puerto Rican doctors and billing practices.

Purpose and Objectives

Purpose:

- The purpose of this project is to quantitatively compare the payments made by private health insurers for doctor visits and for common medical procedures in Puerto Rico with the payments made by health insurers in the US mainland.

Specific Objectives:

- Determine how much private health insurers pay for initial and follow-up doctor visits in Puerto Rico compared to the United States for four different types of PCPs and 12 different types of Specialists.
- Find out how much private health insurers pay for common standard medical procedures in Puerto Rico compared to the US.
- Find out what problems doctors in Puerto Rico and the US encounter with billing and payment.

Methodology

- Exploratory in-depth interviews of billing personnel in doctor's offices were conducted in person to acquire knowledge of billing and coding procedures, and make a preliminary selection of which medical procedures are most frequently performed and billed by doctors in each subdivision, and gain insight into aspects of the study that relate to a specific type of medical practice.
- On the basis of these exploratory interviews, a questionnaire and data collection format were designed. Once these instruments were approved by the **Colegio**, a quantitative survey of billing data from the offices of 189 physicians in Puerto Rico was conducted. The person in charge of billing and coding for each physician was selected (in-house billing personnel or external contractors) and interviewed on the phone, in person or online.
- Four subdivisions of PCP (Family Medicine, Pediatrics, OB/GYN, and Internal Medicine) and 14 subdivisions of Specialists were interviewed.

Methodology

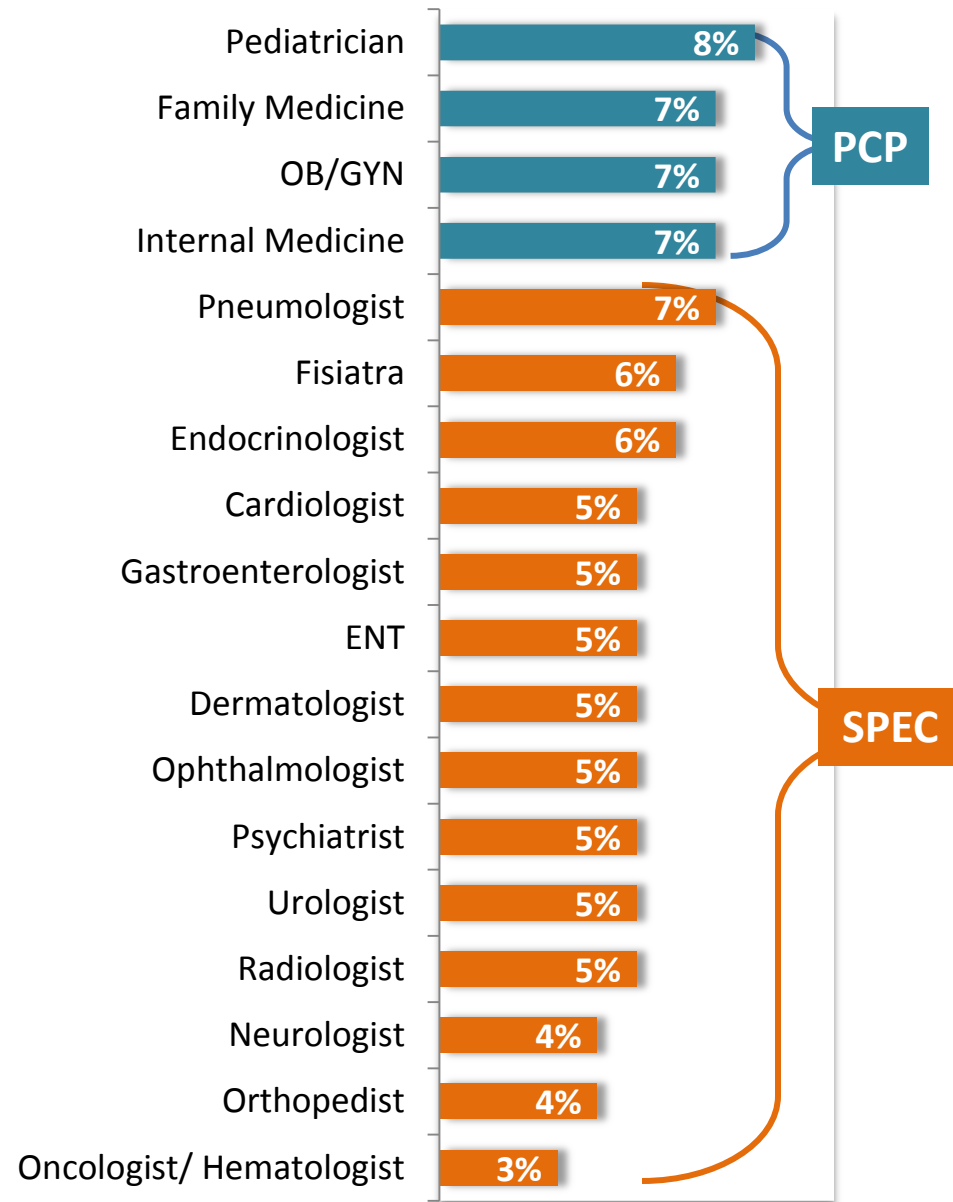
- **The questionnaire asked respondent's to provide information regarding:**
 - Type of medical practice and geographic area of medical practice
 - Percentage of patients who use private health plans, government health plans, or have no plan
 - Billing practices: in house or outside, manual or electronic, computer program used if billing is done electronically
 - Private health plans accepted and relative importance of these plans in medical practice
 - Frequency with which private health plans are billed and time taken for doctor to receive payment
 - Problems experienced with billing and payment
 - Amount that private patients with no plan and patients with private Health Plans pay for first visit and subsequent visits to each type of PCP and each type of Specialist.
 - Amount that private patients with no plan and patients with private Health Plans pay for common medical procedures offered by each type of PCP or Specialist



Characteristics of Medical Practices of Doctors Surveyed

Current Medical Practice

- Of the total sample of 189 doctors, 29% were Primary Care Physicians (PCPs) and 71% were Specialists.
- The PCPs were evenly distributed among pediatricians, Family Medicine, OB/GYN, and Internal Medicine
- 14 different medical specialties were represented

Location of Medical Practice

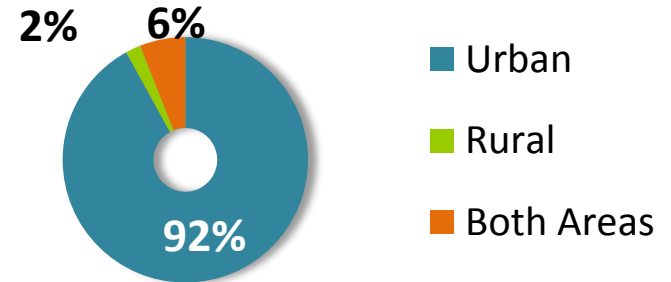
- A large majority (92%) of the doctors have their medical practice in urban areas, only 2% in rural areas and 6% in both (urban and rural areas).
- Most medical practices were located in commercial areas (70%), 4% exclusively in residential areas and 25% had practices located in both areas.
- A large majority (86%) of doctors have their practice close to a hospital.

5. Your medical practice is located in urban area, rural area or both areas?

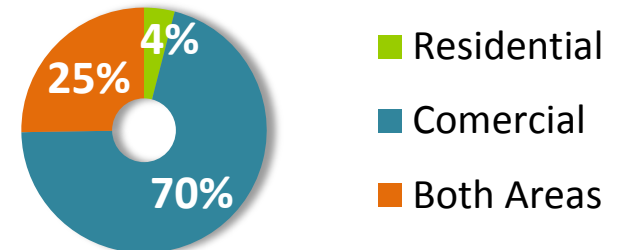
6. Your office is located in residential or commercial area?

7 Your office is located close to a hospital?.

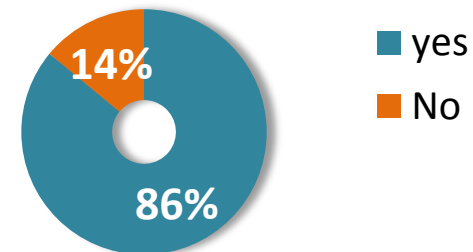
Area – Urban / Rural

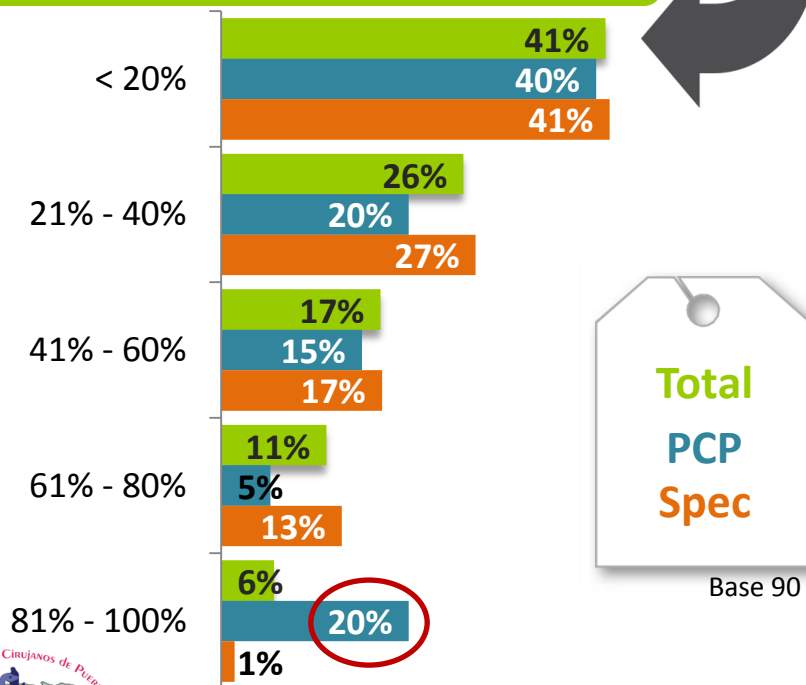

- Slightly less than half (48%) of all doctors accept the Commonwealth Health Plan *Mi Salud*. A higher proportion of Specialists than PCPs accept *Mi Salud* (52% compared to 36%).
- Of those doctors who accept *Mi Salud*:
 - Four out of ten (both PCPs and Specialists) said that 20% or less of patients use the Government Plan
 - Another 26% reported that between 21% to 40% use it.
 - Thus a total of two-thirds said 40% or less of patients use *Mi Salud*.
 - One out of five PCPs said that 81%-100% of patients use *Mi Salud*.

Billing Processing

How Billing is Handled

- The vast majority (83%) do internal billing
- No one does manual billing only, and the vast majority (81%) only do electronic billing
- **Secure Claim** is the most widely used billing program, particularly popular among PCPs
- Specialists more likely to use **Assertus** and **Medic Max** than PCPs

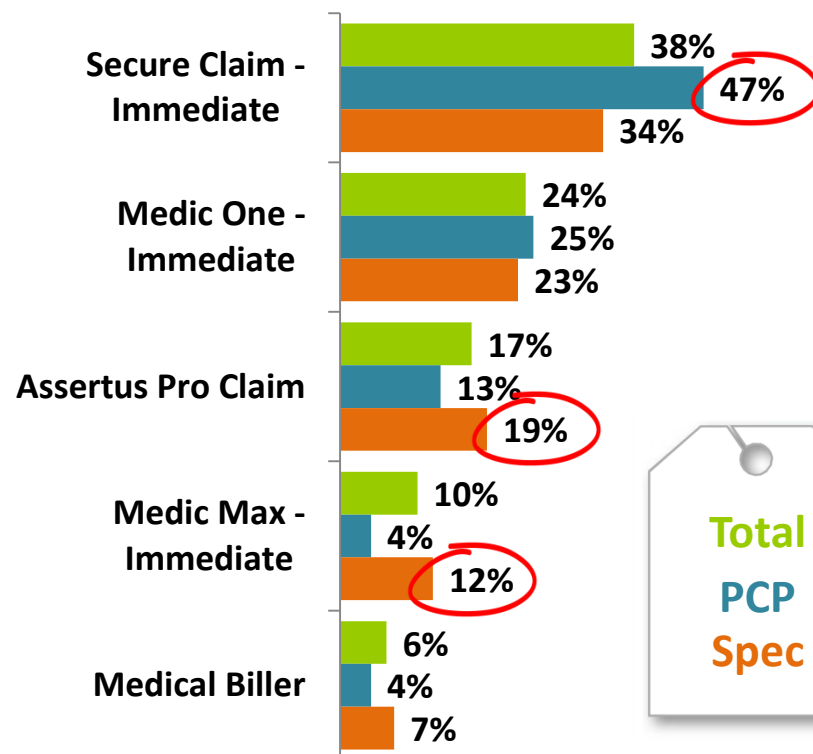

Distribution of Billing

- Private health plans represent 49% of total monthly billing for all doctors, slightly higher for PCPs (54%) than Specialists (47%).
- Medicare and *Mi Salud* account for 32% and 30% of billing, respectively. *Mi Salud*, significantly higher among PCPs than Specialists.

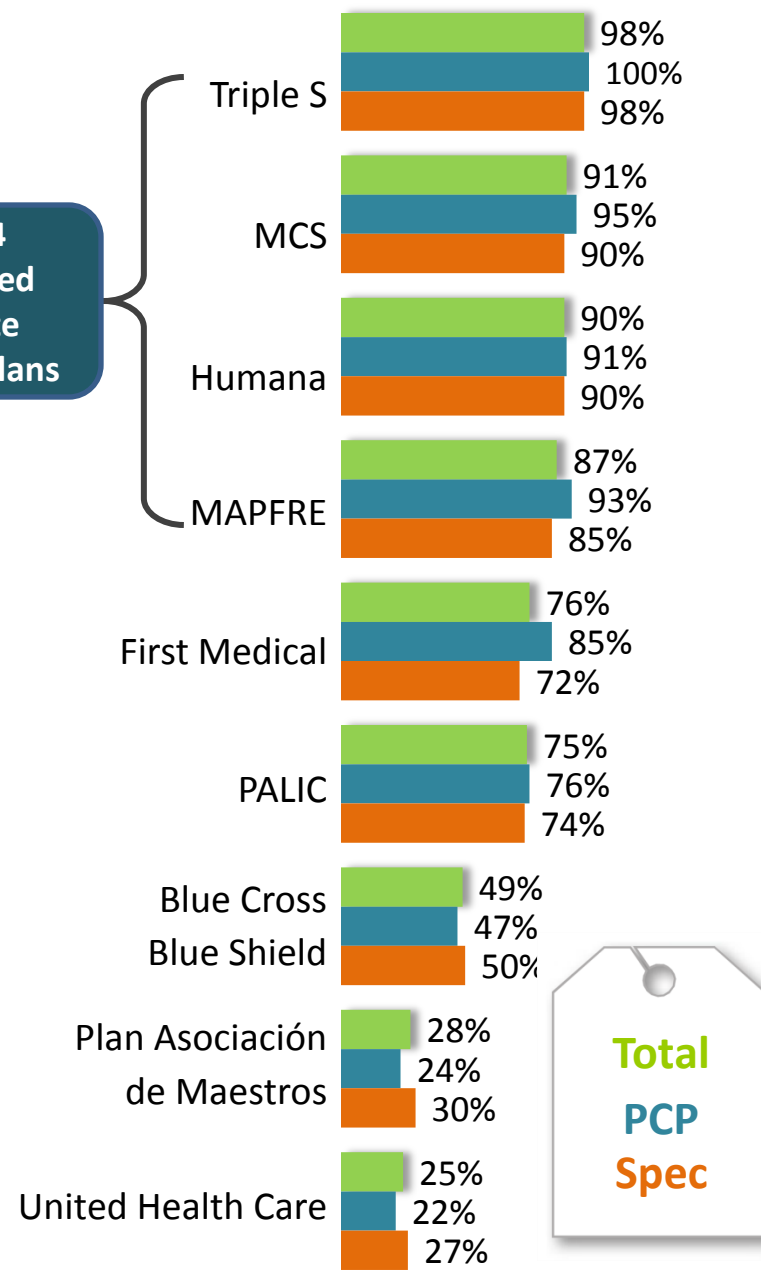

Medical Insurance Accepted by Doctors - Overall

- The most accepted private health plans are **Triple S** (98% of all doctors), **MCS** (91%), **Humana** (90%) and **MAPFRE** (87%).
- First Medical and PALIC each are accepted by about 75% of all doctors.
- Significantly more PCPs than Specialists accept First Medical (85% vs. 72%).

Billing Frequency: Triple S, MCS, Humana

- 40% of doctor's offices bill Triple S, MCS, and Humana daily
- 36% bill these three health plans weekly
- About three quarter of doctor's offices bill these plans either daily or weekly
- PCPs are more likely to bill daily, while Specialists are slightly more likely to bill weekly

Billing Frequency –MAPRE, First Medical, PALIC

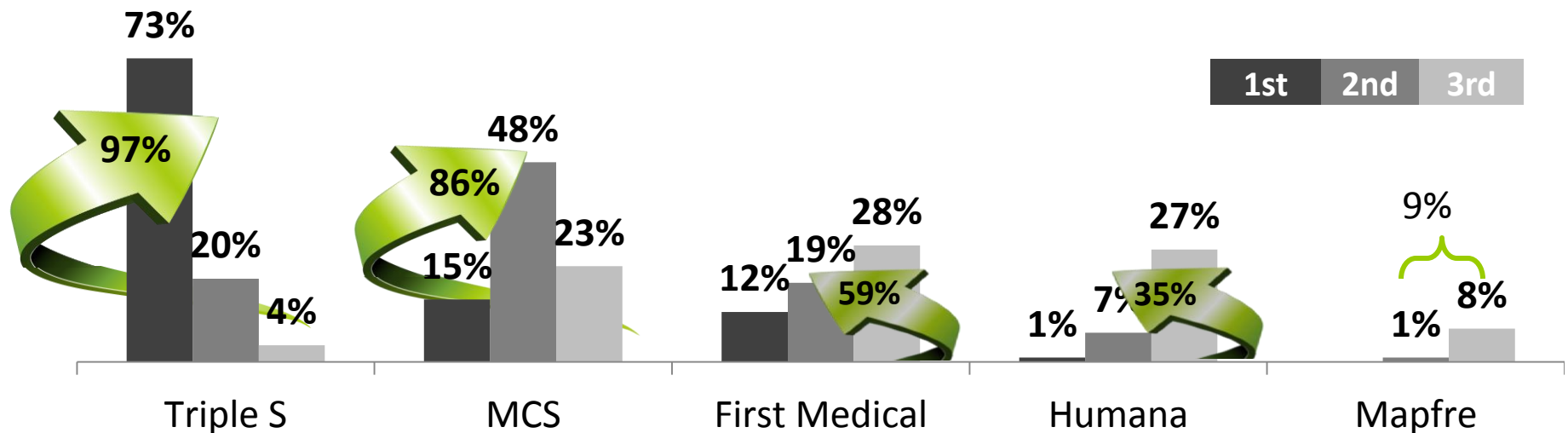
- About 38% of doctors who accept MAPFRE, First Medical and PALIC bill them daily
- About 35% bill these health plans weekly
- Slightly less than three quarters of all doctors bill these three health plans either daily or weekly
- PCPs are more likely to bill these plans daily, while Specialists are slightly more likely to bill weekly

Medical Insurance Volume Billing - Overall

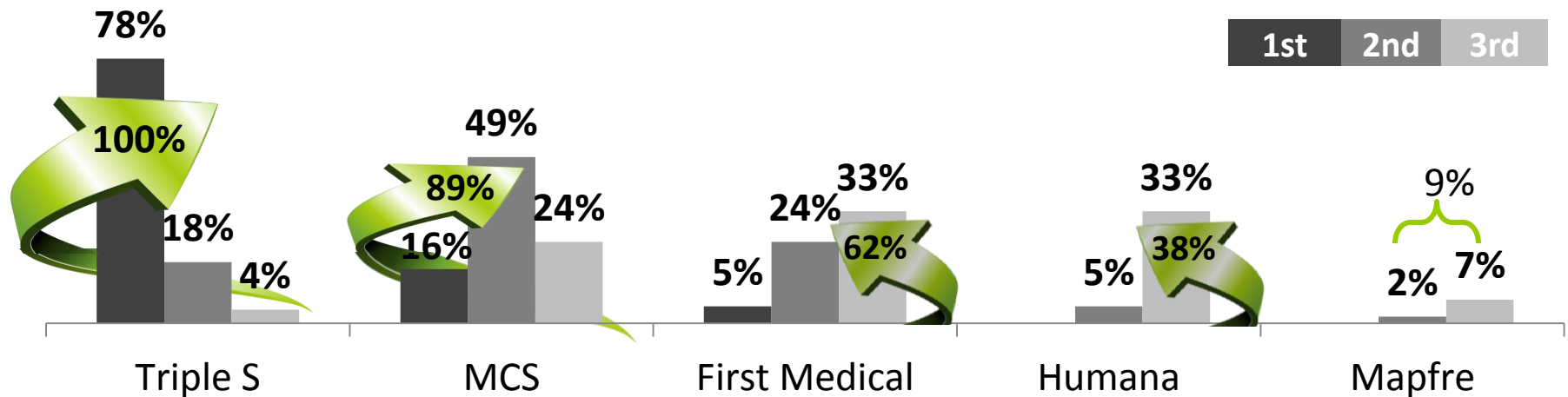
- Of all doctors, 73% said they billed **Triple S** more frequently than any other health plan, and 20% said Triple S was the second most frequently billed. Triple S was among the top three most billed plans for 97% of all doctors.
- MCS** was the most frequently billed plan for 15% of doctors and the second most frequently billed for 48%. MCS was among the top three billed plans for 86% of doctors.
- First Medical was the most frequently billed plan for 12% of doctors and was among the top three most billed plans for 59% of doctors.

Medical Insurance Volume Billing - PCP

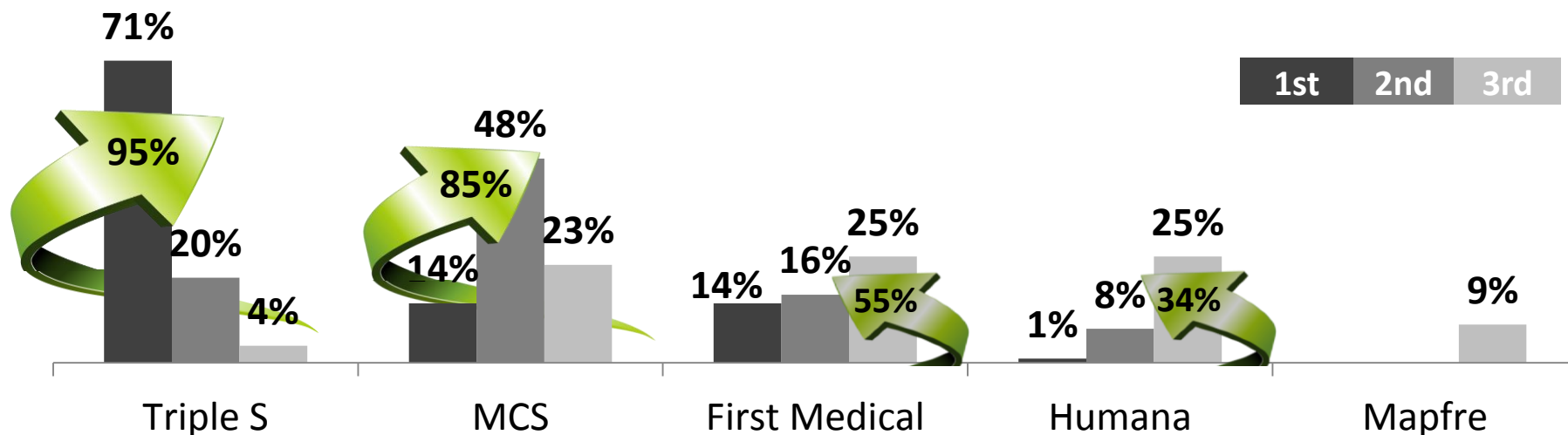
- Of all PCPs, 78% said they billed **Triple S** more frequently than any other health plan, and 18% said Triple S was the second most frequently billed. Triple S was among the top three most billed plans for 100% of all PCPs.
- MCS** was the most frequently billed plan for 16% of PCPs and the second most frequently billed for 49%. MCS was among the top three billed plans for 89% of PCPs.
- First Medical** was among the top three most frequently billed plans for 62% of PCPs compared to 38% for Humana. On the other hand Humana was the second most frequently billed plan for 33% of PCPs compared to 24% for First Medical.

Medical Insurance Volume Billing - Specialists

- Of Specialists, 71% said they billed **Triple S** more frequently than any other health plan, and 20% said Triple S was the second most frequently billed. Triple S was among the top three most billed plans for 95% of all Specialists.
- MCS** was the most frequently billed plan for 14% of Specialists and the second most frequently billed for 48%. MCS was among the top three billed plans for 85% of Specialists
- First Medical** was the most frequently billed plan for 14% of Specialists and was among the top three most billed plans for 55% of Specialists.

Speed of Payment – All Doctors

- When all doctors were asked which plans come to mind for prompt payment, **MCS** was the most frequently mentioned (65%), followed by **Triple S** (52%), and **Humana** (31%). These were the only three plans more praised for prompt payment than condemned for late payments.
- When asked which plans come to mind for late payment, **First Medical** was most frequently mentioned (42%), followed by **MAPFRE** (26%) and **PALIC** (22%).
- On average, doctors who said payment was prompt said it took 18 days for MCS, 19 for Triple S and 17 Humana. Doctors complaining of late payments said it took 51 days for First Medical, 50 for MAPFRE, and 53 for PALIC.

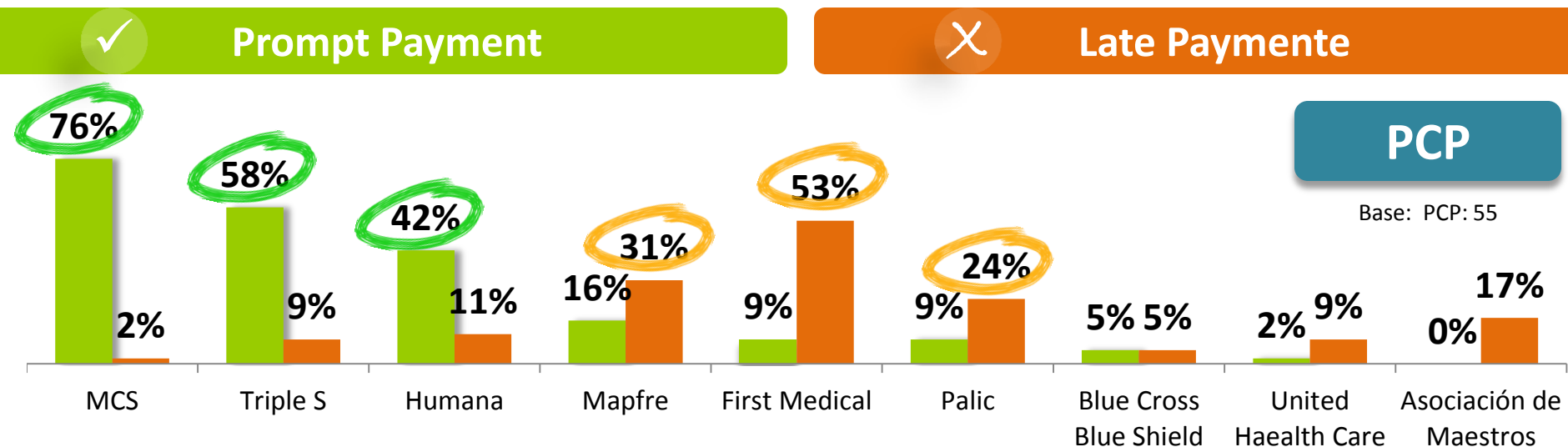

Speed of Payment - PCPs

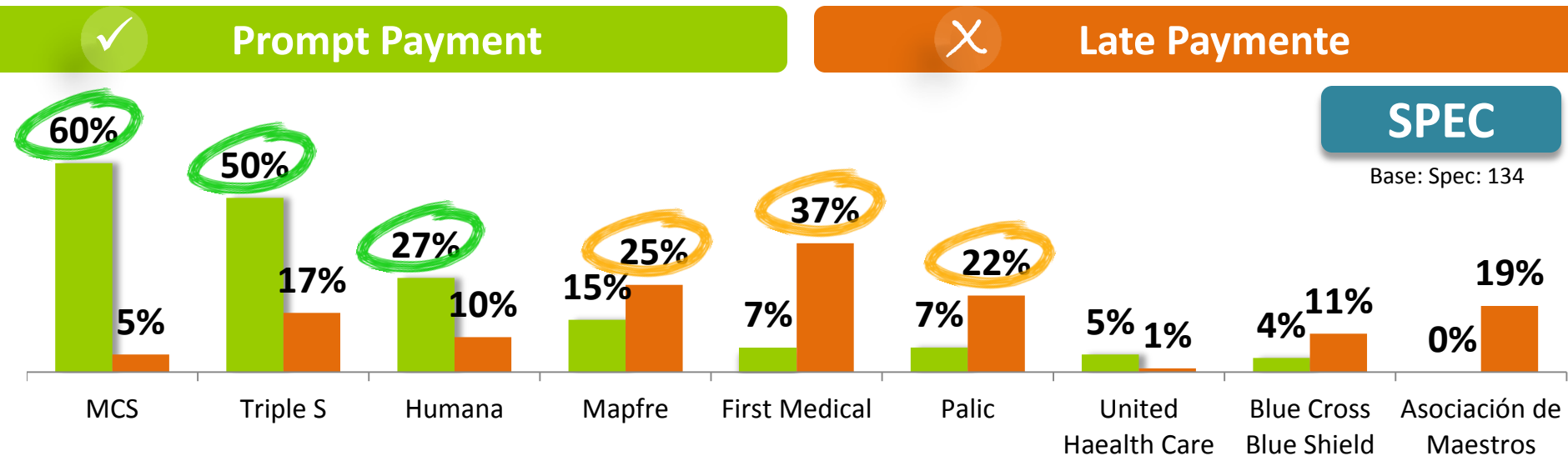
- When all PCPs were asked which plans come to mind for prompt payment, **MCS** was the most frequently mentioned (76%), followed by **Triple S** (58%), and **Humana** (42%). These were the only three plans more praised for prompt payment than condemned for late payments.
- When asked which plans come to mind for late payment, **First Medical** was the most frequently mentioned by PCPs (53%), followed by **MAPFRE** (31%) and **PALIC** (24%).

Speed of Payment - Specialists

- When all Specialists were asked which plans come to mind for prompt payment, **MCS** was the most frequently mentioned (60%), followed by **Triple S** (50%), and **Humana** (27%). These three plans were more praised for prompt payment than condemned for late payments.
- When asked which plans come to mind for late payment, **First Medical** was the most frequently mentioned by Specialists (37%), followed by **MAPFRE** (25%) and **PALIC** (22%).

Billing – Level of Difficulty & Common Reasons for Returns

- On a scale of 1 to 7 in which 1 signified easy coding and 7 difficult coding, the mean value was 2, so most respondents found coding fairly easy.
- For all doctors, the top three reasons for billing returns were: incorrect insured number, incorrect code, and referrals. Referrals were less troublesome for PCPs since they are usually the first doctors consulted.

Top Billing Problems

- When the 189 respondents were asked to comment spontaneously on problems encountered with billing, 44 said there were no problems or didn't comment.
- For the 145 respondents that commented, the top billing problem was related to the patient's insurance or coverage: inactive insurance or the patient did not inform the doctor of a change in insurance, services not covered by insurance, or an error in the contract number.
- The second most important problem for all 145 doctors was an error in matching codes with procedures.
- Errors in referrals were more important for Specialists (17%) and wrong demographic information was more important for PCPs (18%).

Additional Comments

When asked to make additional comments, 143 of the 189 respondents had no additional comment. Of the 46 respondents who commented, the two most important complaints were:

- Low payment rates by insurance companies and low rates in comparison to the 50 states (22%)
- Poor customer service offered by health insurance companies (15%)

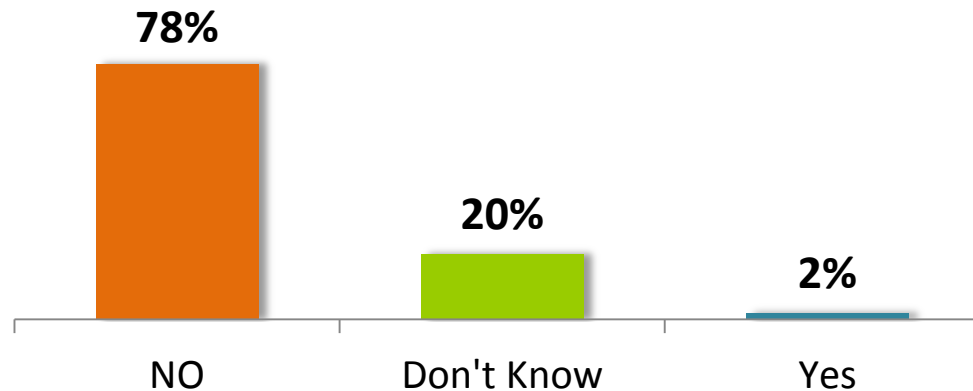

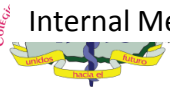
